The story – Part 1

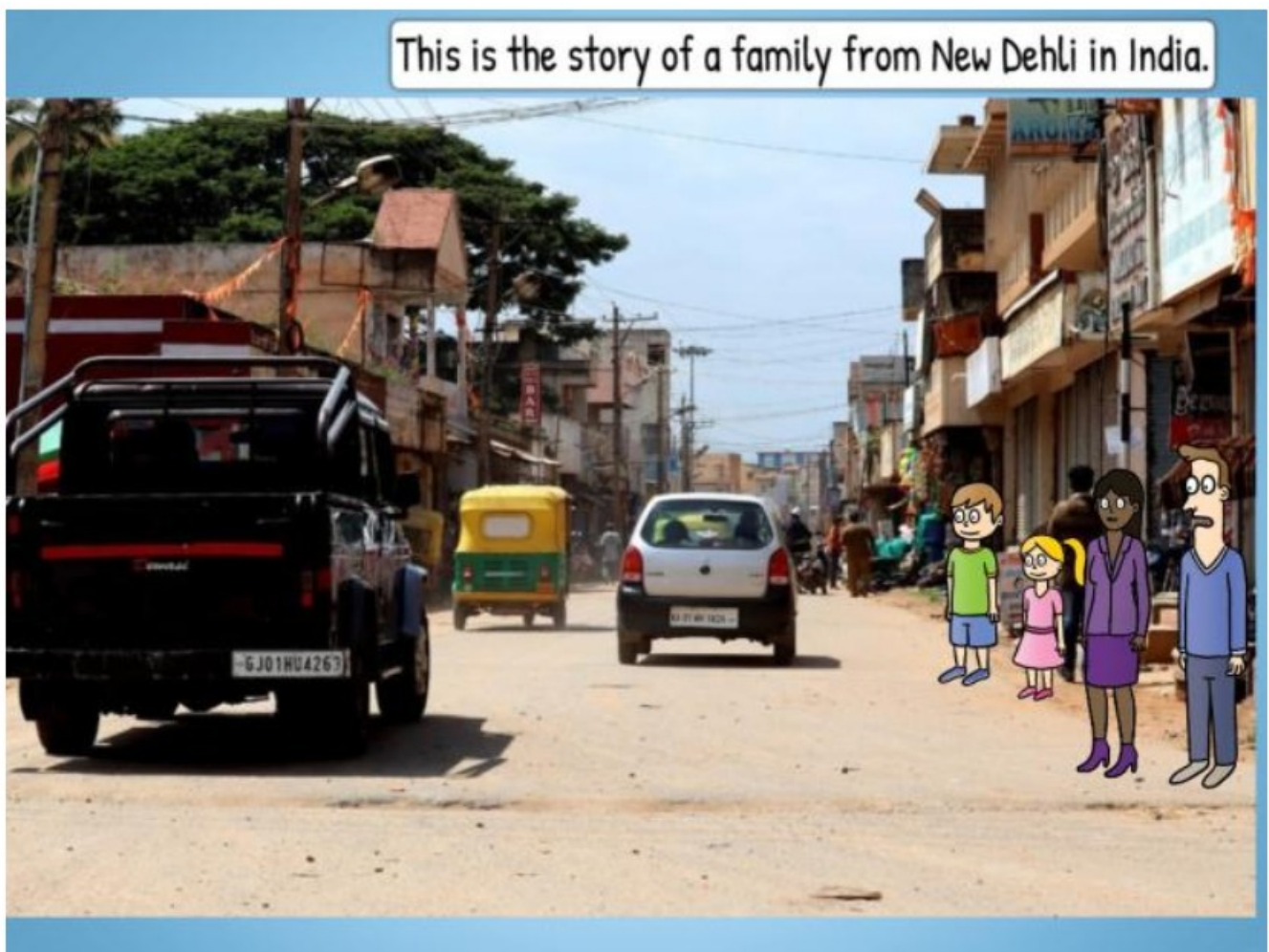
It is a story about a family of four people.

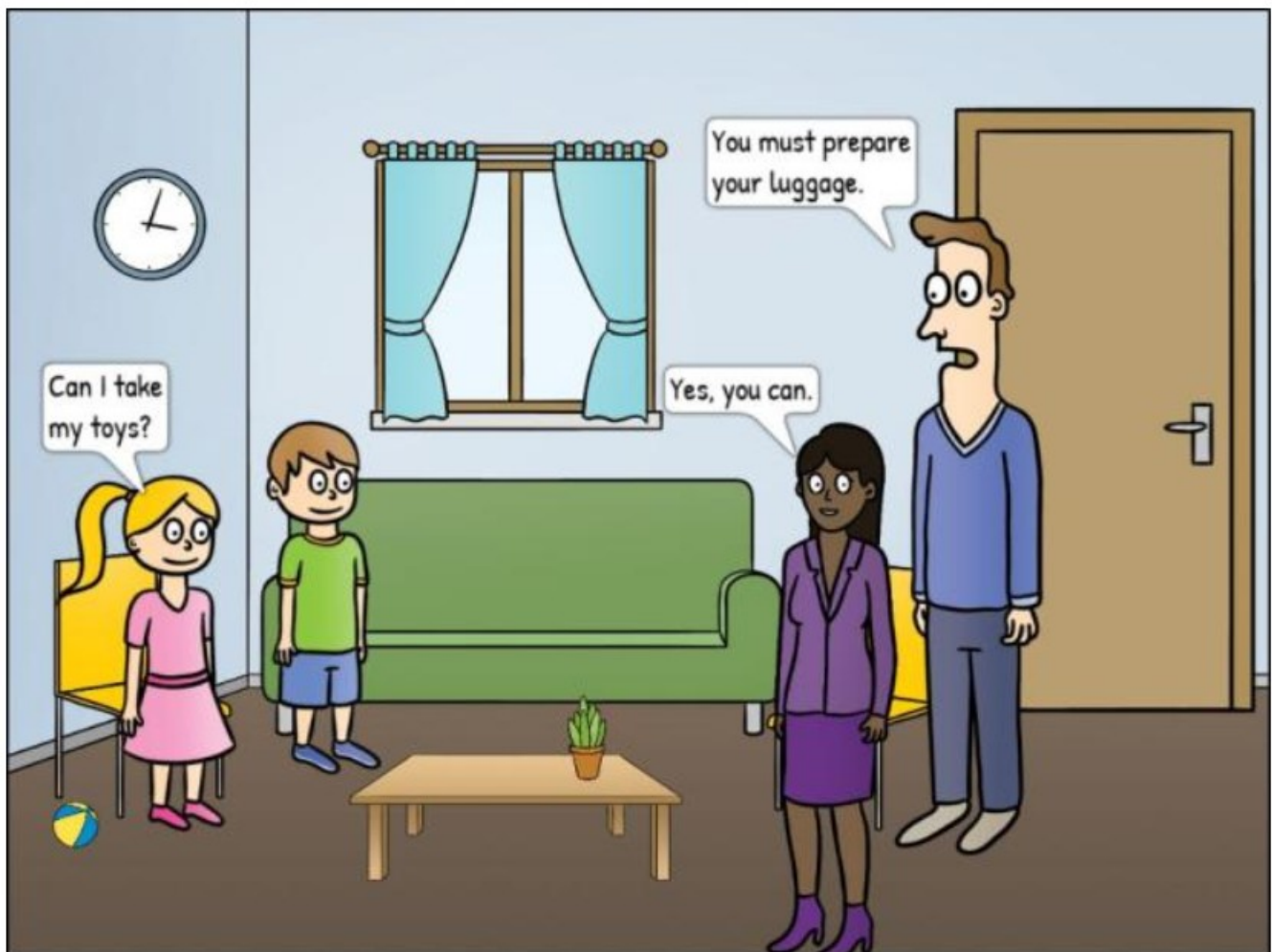
The father's name is Felix and the mother's name is Jessica. The children are James and Cindy. James is 11 years old and Cindy is 9 years old.

All the family prepare their luggage before travelling. They pack their clothes and belongings.



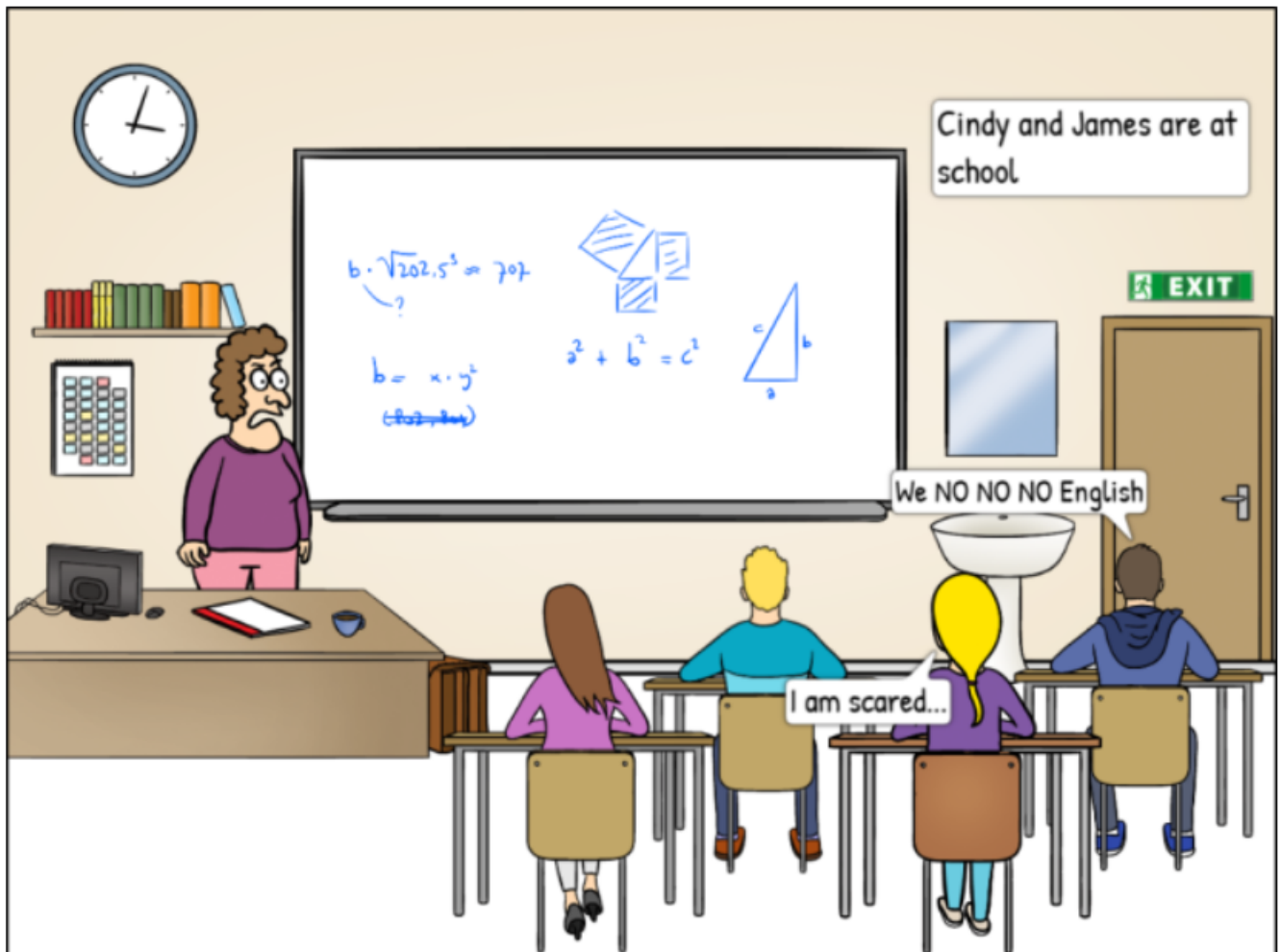
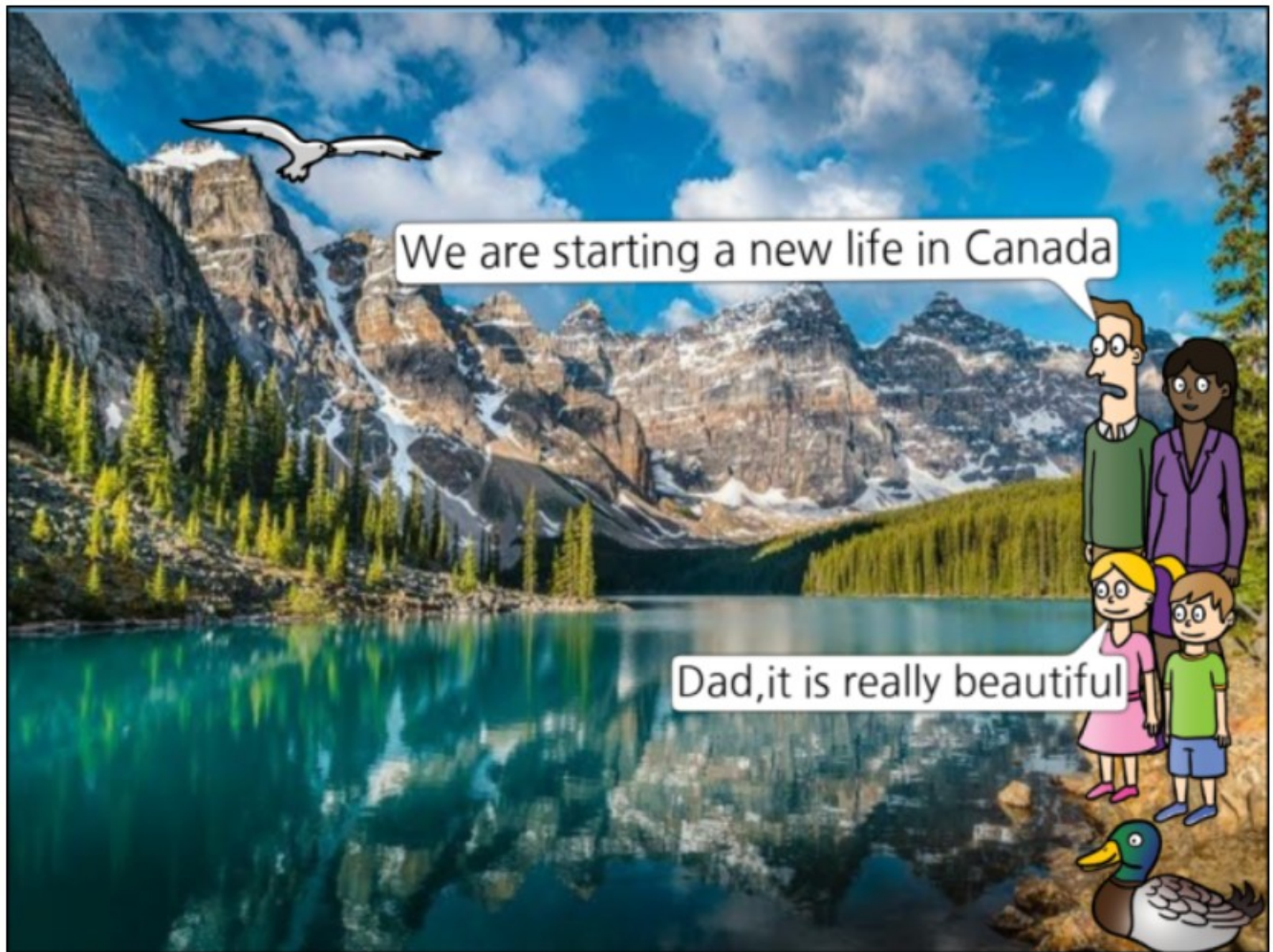




part 2

Their house is big. There are four bedrooms, one living room, one dining room, one bathroom and one kitchen. Their **neighbours** are nice and **helpful**.

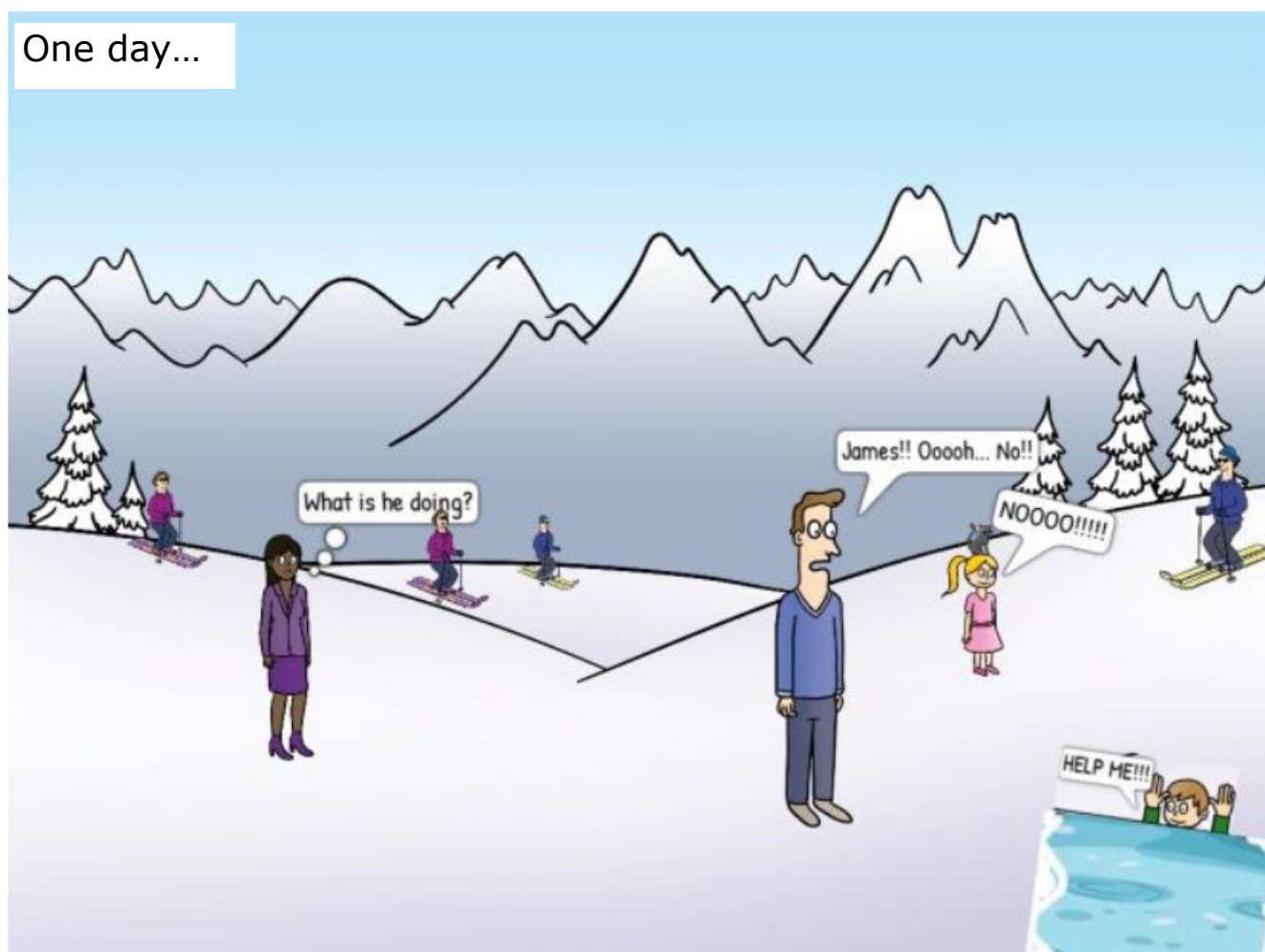
The children go to school. They learn English, mathematics, P. E., History and French. But they are sad because of their **lack of acceptance** of their new situation. They don't have any friends.

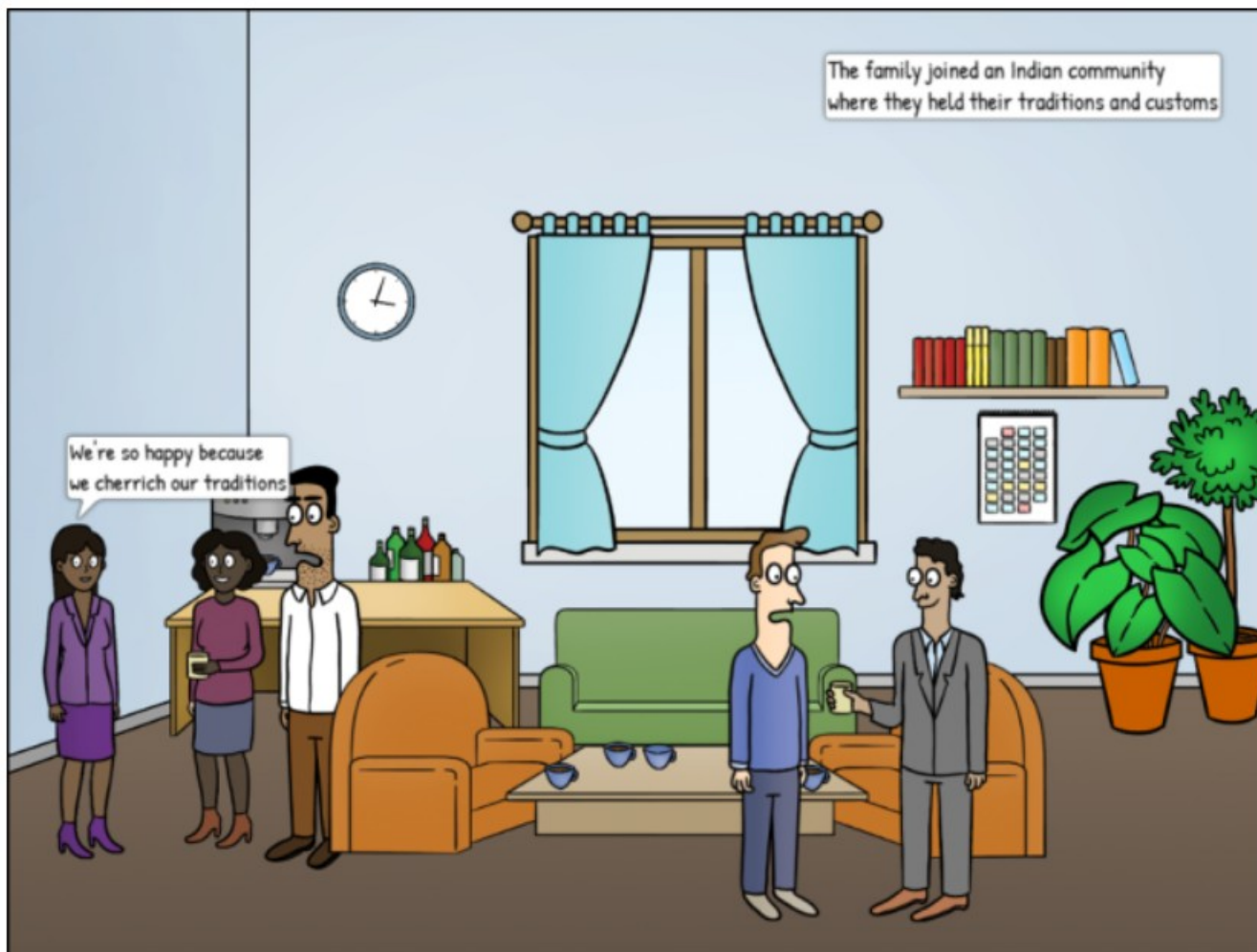
